

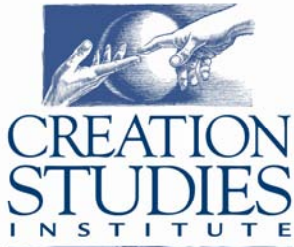

Topic Descriptions

1st Quarter:

August 25 – Sept. 15 Alternative Sources of Energy
Wind, Water, Sun, and Radioactive Materials will be investigated as sources to produce energy.

September 22 – Oct. 13 Invisible Things

Observe the smaller than the eye can see creatures and discover their functions that God has designed.

2nd Quarter:

October 20 – Nov. 10 Human Senses

Learn about the anatomy of seeing, hearing, smelling, tasting, and feeling. Investigate the way science extends the senses to help make observations of God's Creation.

November 17 – Dec. 15 Systems of the Human Body

Study the anatomy and function of the circulatory, digestive, respiratory, and excretory systems in the human body

Topic Descriptions

3rd Quarter:

January 12 – Feb. 2 Simple Machines

Discover that work can be made easier by the use of a lever, pulley, a wheel and axle, a screw, a wedge, and an incline plane.

February 9 – March 2 Ice Age Creatures/ Sharks

Investigate the animals of the Ice Age. Are any of these animals alive today?

4th Quarter:

March 9– March 30 Chemistry of the Ocean

Investigate the chemical environment of the ocean for God's creatures. Is the environment the same today as it was at Creation?

April 13– May 4 Wetlands of Florida

Study the wetland ecosystem of Florida and its inhabitants. Find out whether other ecosystems exist throughout Florida.
